Program # (CA2) EMAPW02 - Pornography: I Thought I was the Only One

Focus passage – 1 Corinthians 10:13, *“No temptation has overtaken you that is not common to man. God is faithful, and he will not let you be tempted beyond your ability, but with the temptation he will also provide the way of escape, that you may be able to endure it.”*

1) When was the first time you looked at a picture of a naked woman or pornography?

2) What are some reasons why men don't share this burden?

“There is none righteous, not even one.” Romans 3:10

3) What is the first thing to remember when struggling with trying to quit using pornography?

“If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.” 1 John 1:9

4) What is the second thing to remember when struggling to quit using pornography?

5) What is the third thing to remember when struggling to quit using pornography?

Commitment: I commit to confessing and addressing any lust issues I have.

Pornography: I Thought I was the Only One – LEADER’S GUIDE

1. Thank everyone for coming.
2. Open in prayer
3. Read the focus passage.
4. Ask men to answer Question #1. Remind the men that what is said in the meeting is confidential.
5. Listen to the program: “Pornography: I Thought I was the Only One”
6. After the program is finished, allow time for comments or questions on the program
7. Review the answers to the four remaining questions with the men in the group.
Encourage everyone to participate, but never force or shame someone into participating.
 - a. Question #2 answer: Sample answers: men think they are the only one. Men think a little porn is unimportant, Men are afraid if others knew, they’d lose respect or be rejected. .
 - b. Question #3 answer: Through Jesus Christ, God forgives.
 - c. Question #4 answer: God provides help.
 - d. Question #5 answer: God provides and escape.
8. Ask the men what was most important to them from this teaching.
9. Ask the men to commit to being open, honest, humble, and accountable regarding any lust in their life.
10. Confirm the time for the next meeting
11. Take prayer requests.
12. Close in prayer

Sample prayer: Heavenly Father, thank you for loving us enough to forgive us our sins and provide escapes from our temptations. Help us to be godly men in our private time. In Jesus name, Amen.
