## Extramarital Sex: I Didn't Know it was a Sin – LEADER'S GUIDE

1. Thank everyone for coming.
2. Open in prayer
3. Read the focus passage.
4. Ask men to answer Question #1. Remind the men that what is said in the meeting is confidential. Add after they answer the question: what if the wife was mean? or didn't want sex?
5. Listen to the program: "Extramarital Sex: I Didn't Know it was a Sin"
6. After the program is finished, allow time for comments or questions on the program
7. Review the answers to the four remaining questions with the men in the group. Encourage everyone to participate, but never force or shame someone into participating.
  - a. Question #2 answer: God created Adam and Eve as sexual beings.
  - b. Question #3 answer: Sexual intercourse between two unmarried people.
  - c. Question #4 answer: It is contrary to His plan for sexual intimacy and must stop.
  - d. Question #5 answer:
    1. Flee sexual immorality. Stop the unbiblical sexual behavior.
    2. Remember that God forgives those who confess, seek His forgiveness, and repent. (1 Corinthians 8:1).
    3. Meet with another Christian man to help you seek God's biblical guidance to stay sexually pure.
8. Ask the men what was most important to them from this teaching.
9. Ask the men to commit to challenging each other to use biblical boundaries for their sexually behavior.
10. Confirm the time for the next meeting
11. Take prayer requests.
12. Close in prayer

Sample prayer: Almighty God, please forgive us for not following Your plan for sexual intimacy. Give us the strength to follow Your guidelines from this day forward. In Jesus name, Amen.
