Focus passage – Philippians 4:8, *“Finally, brothers and sisters, whatever is true, whatever is noble, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is admirable—if anything is excellent or praiseworthy—think about such things.”*

Commitment: I commit to flee from situations of sexual temptation.

Pornography: The Flee Principle - LEADER'S GUIDE

1. Thank everyone for coming.
2. Open in prayer
3. Read the focus passage.
4. Ask men to answer Question #1. Remind the men that what is said in the meeting is confidential.
5. Listen to the program: Pornography: The Flee Principle
6. After the program is finished, allow time for comments or questions on the program
7. Review the answers to the remaining four questions with the men in the group.
Encourage everyone to participate, but never force or shame someone into participating.
 - a. Question #2 answer: a) Satan, b) the lust of our flesh, and c) the world around us
 - b. Question #3 answer: Actually fleeing. Remove ourselves from the sexually tempting situation.
 - c. Question #4 answer: Putting up hedges of protection that reduce sexual temptation.
 - d. Question #5 answer: We run to Jesus.
8. Ask the men what will be their biggest obstacle to applying this teaching.
9. Ask the men to commit to challenging each other to flee from temptation.
10. Confirm the time for the next meeting
11. Take prayer requests.
12. Close in prayer

Sample prayer: Almighty God, thank You, when I am tempted sexually, You have provided an escape from that temptation. Please help me to see the escape and use it. In Jesus name, Amen.
